Please note latest updates on Hong Kong Airport:

Announcement for Access Control at Hong Kong international Airport

Access control at the terminal buildings of Hong Kong International Airport is being implemented. Until further notice, only departure passengers with a valid air ticket or boarding pass for a flight in the next 24 hours and a valid travel document will be allowed to enter the terminal buildings. Passengers are reminded to arrive at the airport three hours before their departure time for the relevant checks. Other members of the public, including those who may want to accompany departure passengers or receiving arrival passengers at the airport should not travel to the airport unless absolutely necessary.

Interim injunction to restrain persons from unlawfully and willfully obstructing or interfering with the proper use of HKIA

The Airport Authority has obtained an interim injunction to restrain persons from unlawfully and willfully obstructing or interfering with the proper use of Hong Kong International Airport (the Airport).

Persons are also restrained from attending or participating in any demonstration or protest or public order event in the Airport other than in the area designated by the Airport Authority. The interim injunction expressly provides that nothing in the interim injunction shall be construed as authorizing any demonstration, protest or public order event contrary to the Public Order Ordinance.
